### LUGGAGE LIMITATIONS

- 11:00 am **Gateway Arch**. Gaze at over 43,000 tons of concrete and steel making an iconic, elegant arc 63-stories stories high into the Midwest sky. Shaped by the inspired design of Finnish-America architect Eero Saarinen, the Gateway Arch celebrates the westward expansion of the United States and the pioneers who made it possible. Since its completion in 1965, the monument has taken millions of visitors on the four-minute trip to the top to enjoy stunning views stretching up to 30 miles to the east and west. Begin your tour with the new, interactive pre-boarding exhibits featuring 60s era animation and Gateway Arch trivia. Then, be transported 630 feet to the top of America's tallest man-made monument.
- Gateway Arch Museum**. Brand New! See history differently. Trace the story of the Native Americans, explorers, pioneers, and rebels who made America possible. Featuring six themed exhibit areas, this innovative and interactive museum celebrates America's pioneering spirit.
- Monument to the Dream**. Soaring above the banks of the Mississippi River in St. Louis, MO, the Gateway Arch (formerly known as the Jefferson National Expansion Memorial Arch) stands today as the nation's tallest arch and national monument. "Monument to the Dream", at unnerving heights, traces the adventures of the Arch's evolution, from the early concepts on the drawing board to the fabrication of its stainless-steel sections, and the triumphant placement of its final section in the fall of 1965.
- Gateway Arch – Journey to the Top**. Discover magnificent views from the top of St. Louis' Gateway Arch—an iconic monument symbolizing the city's role as early settlers pioneered westward years ago. See both the history and culture surrounding the city—from 630 feet high in this architectural wonder. 11:00 am
- 2:00 pm Walk to **Ballpark Village**.
- 2:15 pm **Lunch** at **Ballpark Village**. Enjoy a buffet lunch at the first ever sports anchored entertainment district located next to Busch Stadium, home of the St. Louis Cardinals. You'll feast on classic burgers, grilled chicken sandwiches, mac-n-cheese, grilled chicken Caesar salad, house-made chips & salsa with cheese sauce, a delicious dessert, and refreshing beverages!

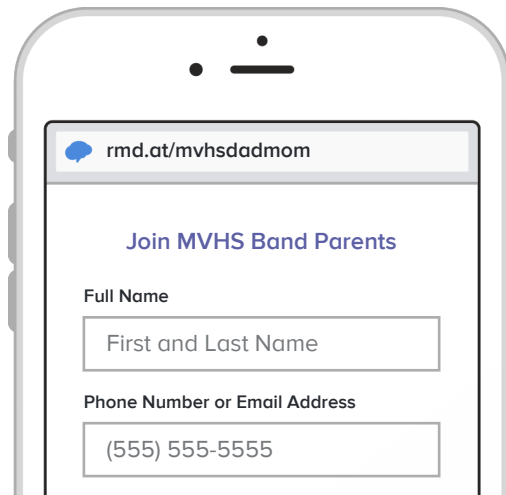

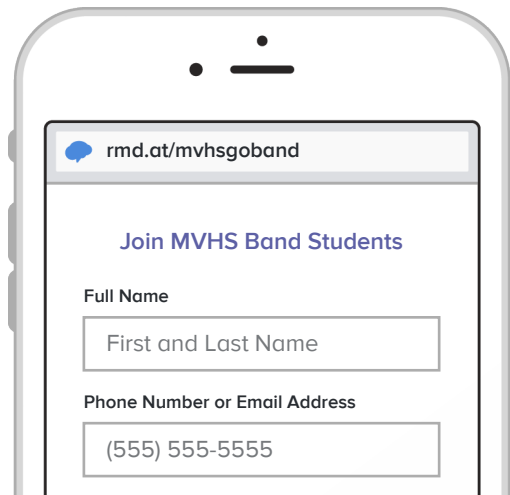

## Packing Tips

- ✓ **Pack a bag, but not a giant bag!** One (1) medium sized suitcase (25" H x 16" L x 9" D) please. If you're traveling overnight to your destination, pack an overnight bag with a change of clothes & toiletries for the morning.

- ✓ **Visit [www.weather.com](http://www.weather.com) to check temperatures & the possibility for inclement weather during your travels.** Pack accordingly & plan for sunscreen, rain gear, & cold weather garb.
- ✓ **Make yourself cozy on the bus!** Bring along a pillow, blankie, & sweater.
- ✓ **Performing groups will be advised by their directors what performance & uniform items are needed.** Pack an extra pair of black socks. Those always go missing!

## On Board the Coach

- The motorcoach is your communal living room for the duration of the trip. **Keep the coach clean.** Be polite. Share. Smile at your bus driver. High five your chaperones. Laugh a lot, but keep the decibel level low.
- **Bottled water & packaged snacks** are available throughout the trip (yea)! Participants are welcome to bring along additional goodies. Dairy products and glass bottles are not allowed on the coach. This includes ice cream, yogurt, & blended drinks.
- In most cases, motorcoaches will be equipped with **Wi-Fi & on board plug ins** throughout the coach. Wi-Fi can be sporadic while traveling. Plug ins are located every couple of rows on the coach & will be shared.
- **G or PG DVD movies** are welcomed on board the coach. PG-13 movies will be shown at the discretion of the chaperones on board. Movies with excessive language or adult situations will not be shown & could be tossed out the door of the motorcoach. Leave those at home.
- An adult must be on board the coach in order for students to be allowed to board.

- All participants will be invited to join in a **Text Messaging Group** for the tour that they are traveling on. Participants on the trip will receive text timeline reminders throughout the tour & any directives necessary for the next step in their travels.
- Parents can also sign up for a **What-Is-My-Kid-Up-To Text Messaging Group** so that they can keep track of their child's adventures! Our Tour Directors will send out periodic messages to parents to advise them of where the group is, what exciting things they have seen & how the day progressed.
