Thomas Jefferson's Monticello. Get an intimate look at the extraordinary house Thomas Jefferson built and furnished for himself and his family. See the furnishings, art, books, gadgets and other objects that reveal Jefferson's unique mind. You'll also have time to explore Jefferson's lifelong interest in gardening, botany, and agriculture while enjoying the beauty of Monticello's grounds and gardens.

George Washington's Mount Vernon Estate & Gardens. You are invited to tour the Mansion house and more than a dozen outbuildings including the slave quarters, kitchen, stables, and greenhouse.

Library of Congress Tour. You'll take a walking tour of the historic Thomas Jefferson building to learn about its symbolic art and architecture. Docents tell the story of the Library, America's oldest cultural institution: its history, collections, and services for Congress and the nation.

National Archives Experience. The National Archives Experience is the home of the original Declaration of Independence, Constitution, and Bill of Rights which are housed in the Rotunda for the Charters of Freedom, the Public Vaults permanent exhibit gallery, the Lawrence F. O'Brien temporary exhibit gallery, the Boeing Learning Center and the William G. McGowan Theater.

U.S. Holocaust Memorial Museum. It is estimated that 6 million Jews were put to death as part of Hitler's "Final Solution." You can pay tribute to the Holocaust victims and learn more about this time in history as you explore the main exhibit.

Cancellation Penalties

Documentation for the reason for cancellation will be required. If you can be replaced on a trip, a full refund less a \$25.00 fee will be given.
