**Highlights include:**

**Arlington National Cemetery.** You'll observe the quiet dignity of Arlington National Cemetery, the final resting place of more than 200,000 veterans and their families. At JFK's gravesite, you'll see the eternal flame that was originally lit by Jacqueline Kennedy at her husband's funeral. You'll also witness the Changing of the Guard at the Tomb of the Unknowns.

**U.S. Capitol Tour.** Guided tours of the historic Capitol begin at the Capitol Visitor Center's orientation theater with a 13-minute film, "Out of Many, One," which will take you on a journey through our country's struggle to establish the world's first truly representative democracy and introduce you to the magnificent building that houses our Congress. Once inside the historic Capitol, visitors will see the Crypt, the Rotunda, and National Statuary Hall.

**George Washington's Mount Vernon Estate & Gardens.** Explore the Mansion house and more than a dozen outbuildings including the slave quarters, kitchen, stables, and greenhouse. Stroll four different gardens, hike the Forest Trail, and explore the George Washington: Pioneer Farmer site, a four-acre working farm that includes a re-creation of Washington's 16-sided treading barn.

**Smithsonian Museums.** Choose among several museums to visit: U.S. Holocaust Memorial Museum; National Museum of American History; National Museum of Natural History; National Air & Space Museum; National Museum of the American Indian; US Bureau of Engraving and Printing; National Museum of African American History and Culture; National Museum of African Art; Hirshhorn Museum and Sculpture Garden; Freer and Sackler Galleries; US Botanic Gardens; and the National Gallery of Art.

**Guided Tour of Colonial Williamsburg.** Step back in time as you explore this 18th-century city. Touted as the world's largest living history museum, Colonial Williamsburg boasts over 40 sites and trades, 4 historic taverns, and 2 world-class art museums in addition to exciting activities and programs.
