Pricing Adjustments & Group Minimum

Tour pricing is subject to a minimum number of paying participants on the trip. Should the group fall short of or exceed that number we may need to make adjustments to the trip package. We will begin a **waiting list** after the first bus is full to determine if we have enough participation for a second bus. Reservations are **first-come, first-served**.

Rooming List
