Highlights include:

Washington, DC Guided Tour. You will see the historic background of our nation and have the opportunity to see the buildings that house the three branches of government as well as other noteworthy DC sites. Views included in your tour today include the 9/11 Pentagon Memorial, Vietnam, Korean, Lincoln Memorials., & much more as time allows.

Steven F. Udvar-Hazy Center. This museum is a companion facility to the National Air and Space Museum on the National Mall. It's two huge hangars — the Boeing Aviation Hangar and the James S. McDonnell Space Hangar — display thousands of aviation and space artifacts, including a Lockheed SR-71 Blackbird, a Concorde, and the Space Shuttle Discovery.

George Washington's Mount Vernon Estate & Gardens. You are invited to tour the Mansion house and more than a dozen outbuildings including the slave quarters, kitchen, stables, and greenhouse. Stroll four different gardens, hike the Forest Trail, and explore the George Washington: Pioneer Farmer site, a four-acre working farm that includes a re-creation of Washington's 16-sided treading barn.

Smithsonian Institution. You will have your choice of 10 different museums such as: American History Museum; Natural History Museum; Air and Space Museum; American Indian Museum; Postal Museum; American Art Museum; African Art Museum; Hirshborn Museum; Sackler Gallery; and Arts and Industries.

Alexandria History Tour. Guided by colonial-costumed guides, you'll embark on a lantern lit tour of Alexandria's Old Town. Sights include the Carlyle House, Gatsby's Tavern, Christ Church, and George Washington's Town House.

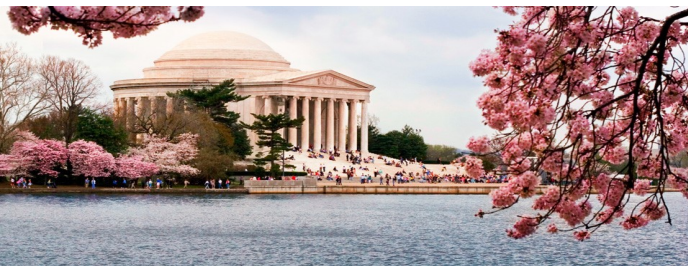

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Only a parent, using his or her email, may register a student for a trip.
2. A headshot photo of your child must be uploaded during the booking process. Photos will be used for chaperone information on the trip.
3. Ready to make your deposit payment by Discover, Mastercard or Visa.

Eligibility

This tour is open to students enrolled in St. Andrews Lutheran School. Students must be in good standing and meet all of the school requirements to be eligible for a field trip.

Chaperones

We want to make this trip a success and we need adult chaperones to help us do that! Adult cost on the tour is as follows: **\$829.00** per person based on 4 to a room; **\$879.00** per person based on 3 to a room; **\$959.00** per person based on 2 to a room; and **\$1,199.00** per person based on 1 to a room. You will be billed for the appropriate occupancy based on your roommate selection.

Reservations

Reservations are accepted on a first-come, first served basis. Trip cost is based on a minimum of paying participants and may be adjusted. The payment schedule is as follows:

\$200.00 payment per person	Due November 15, 2019
\$200.00 payment per person	Due January 17, 2020
Final balance	Due April 3, 2020

Pricing Adjustments

Pricing is based on a minimum of paying participants per bus. Pricing will be adjusted based on the final group number.

Rooming List

Students will be assigned 5 to a room with 2 queen beds and a sleeper sofa. Adult chaperones will be assigned to their preferred occupancy and billed based on the final rooming list.

Cancellation Penalties

Up to 90 days prior	Refund less \$25.00 fee plus any non-recoverable expenses
89-60 days prior	25% trip cost cancellation penalty
59-45 days prior	50% trip cost cancellation penalty
44-00 days prior	No Refund

Trip Cancellation Waiver Protection is available to you for an additional **\$49.00 per person**. This coverage will provide you with a full refund at any time prior to the trip should you have to cancel for illness, death in the family or an emergency situation. Documentation for the reason for cancellation will be required. If you can be replaced on a trip, a full refund less a \$25.00 fee will be given.
