Kalahari Resorts Indoor Waterpark

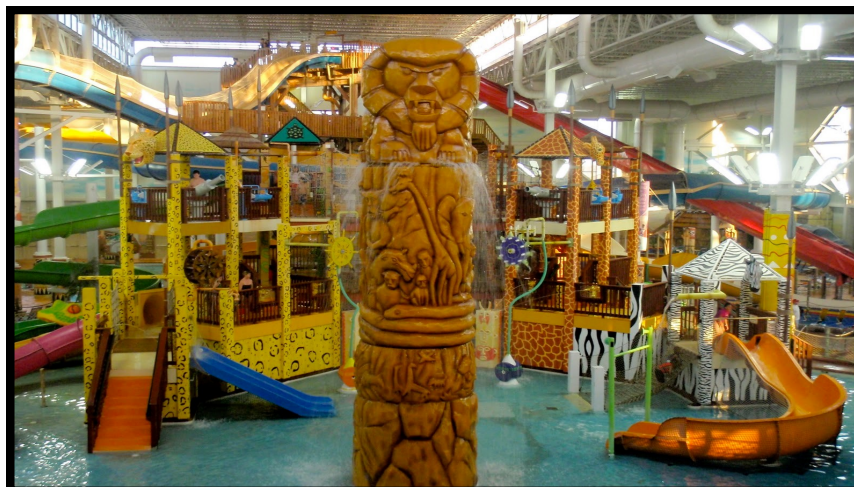

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Only a parent, using his or her email, may register a student for a trip.
2. A photo of your child must be uploaded during the registration process. Photos will be used for chaperone information on the trip.
3. Be ready to make your deposit payment by Discover, Mastercard or Visa. The registration process cannot be completed without payment.

Eligibility

This tour is open to all students enrolled in Brooks Middle School Band and Choir. Students must be in good standing and meet all of the school requirements to be eligible for a field trip.

Chaperones

We want to make this trip a success and we need adult chaperones to help us do that! Parents who are interested in chaperoning this tour must complete the on-line tour registration and pay a \$100 deposit to secure a spot. All chaperones must agree to take responsibility for students in their charge and follow all chaperone guidelines. Chaperone trip costs are **\$385.00** pp double occupancy and **\$469.00** pp single occupancy.

Reservations

Reservations are processed on-line and accepted on a first-come, first served basis. Space is limited so don't delay!! We will open 90 seats on the trip initially and waitlist additional participants to ensure that we have enough interest for a 3rd coach. Trip cost is based on a minimum of paying participants and may be adjusted. The payment schedule is:

Due: October 11, 2019	\$ 100.00 per person deposit payment
Due: November 22, 2019	\$ 125.00 per person installment payment
Due: February 28, 2020	Final balance

Registrations are only accepted with the payment of your booking deposit + optional Trip Cancellation Waiver. Fundraising payments will be applied to your account once the monies have been received in the Entourage Management office. Only complete the registration form if you are prepared to make your deposit payment online.

Fundraising Payments

If you plan to use fundraising funds to make your payments, please make a request through the Booster Treasurer for those funds to be sent to Entourage Management on your behalf. Fundraising payments must be received in our office 2 weeks prior to each payment date to be applied to your account.

Accommodations

Every effort will be made to assign students to quad occupancy rooms sharing 1 King bed and 1 Queen size sleeper sofa. Students will sign up for rooms in class in October. Students rooming together will be riding together on the same bus.

Itinerary Adjustments

Trip cost is based on a minimum of 40 participants per coach. The itinerary is subject to changes if the group does not meet or exceed this number.

Cancellation Penalties
