PACK YOUR BAGS

When preparing to pack for your trip, review your itinerary. Triple check to make sure that you have:

- ✓ One comfortable, casual outfit per day
- ✓ Toiletries (save space and plan to share items with your roomies!)
- ✓ Comfortable walking shoes
- ✓ Black Pants & Polo for Performance
- ✓ Instrument
- ✓ Pajamas
- ✓ Electronics & power cords
- ✓ Sunscreen
- ✓ Sunglasses





PACK YOUR BAGS

Luggage tags should be filled out & attached to all luggage.

Each person is allowed **ONE PIECE of luggage** underneath the coach and on the flight. This should be **MEDIUM SIZE**. You will receive two Entourage luggage tags prior to your trip to be placed on your bigger piece of luggage going beneath the coach and on an instrument, if you have one. Small carry-on bags & small instruments can be placed in the overhead bins and under your seat on the flight.

Maximum weight is 50 pounds and maximum size is 62 inches (length + width + height) per checked piece of luggage. Overweight items from 51 to 70 pounds will be accepted for a fee of \$100 per item. Overweight items from 71 to 100 pounds will incur a fee of \$200 per item. Oversized items in excess of 62 inches but not more than 126 inches will incur a fee of \$200. **Individuals will be responsible for any overweight and oversize charges on their personal luggage.** Fees to check instruments are covered by Entourage Management.

PACK YOUR BAGS

American Airlines Battery Policies:

Up to 2 spare batteries, in a carry-on bag only, are allowed. For a lithium metal battery, the lithium content cannot be more than 2 grams per battery. For lithium-ion batteries, a maximum of 2 batteries, not exceeding 160 Wh each, are allowed, with airline approval.

ACCESS TO INSTRUMENTS

BUS 1 AND BUS 2 TRAVELERS:

Be prepared to bring your instrument home with you on Thursday, February 13, since we might not be able to get into the school on departure day before the first set of buses need to leave for the airport. Mr. Baum will let you know if another plan is worked in the next few weeks. For now, plan to bring everything you'll need for the trip home with you after school on 2/13.





TRANSPORTING INSTRUMENTS

Anyone traveling with an instrument should ensure it has a luggage tag attached to it.

Please refer to the far right-hand column on the Bus Manifests (located on pages 7 – 10 of the Itinerary Packet) to see how you MUST transport your instrument to LA.

Smaller instruments like flutes, violas, clarinets, trumpets, saxophones, violins, etc. MUST be packed inside your checked luggage OR brought onto the plane as a carry-on & stored under the seat in front of you or in an overhead bin. No impromptu jam sessions during the flight!

Medium-sized instruments like trombones, tenor saxophones, alto saxophones, acoustical guitars, French horns, bass clarinets, bass guitars, mellophones, bassoons, baritones, etc. MUST be checked as a 2nd piece of luggage.

Large instruments like tubas, cellos, upright bass, baritone saxophones, drums, cymbals, baritone saxophones, and an upright bass have been rented for the performance at Universal Studios Hollywood. The theme park is providing an electric keyboard.



I.D. REQUIREMENTS

All passengers **18 years of age and older** must show a state or federally-issued photo identification to pass through security checkpoints. Acceptable forms of ID include a **passport, driver's license, military ID, or permanent resident card.**

It is recommended that participants **under 18 years of age** travel with a **photo ID** – preferably government issued if possible. For participants under 18 years of age, a student photo ID is acceptable.



DIETARY NEEDS

Our team is sensitive to dietary needs and will make special arrangements for included meals based on the information that has been provided to us.

Despite our best efforts, it is ultimately **the responsibility of the participant to make their best judgements when it comes to dietary choices** during the trip. Participants should communicate dietary needs and emergency precautions to their chaperones at the beginning of the trip.

Travelers who suffer from complex or extreme food allergies are advised to pack adequate snacks and be prepared with extra meal money to purchase uniquely prepared foods, if necessary.
